A sterling silver, freshwater pearl and enamelled pendant, circa 1910, in a floral and foliate openwork design with a freshwater pearl drop, length 5cm, with a neckchain.

Condition Report

653. The silver is heavily tarnished and would benefit from professional cleaning. There is a small chip to the top flower and a surface chip to the bottom flower. The enamel work although a little crude is in generally good condition. The freshwater pearl drop is starting to peel and has slight brown staining on one side. The half-pearl at the top is in good condition. The back of the pendant is marked 'sterling'. The chain is in good condition.
