Two gold and foil backed amethyst bracelets, circa 1820, each mounted with a row of oval cut foil backed amethysts, on a snap clasp, lengths 17.8cm and 18cm.

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

705. One of the bracelets has been broken, with the resulting loss of one connecting loop. The bracelets are otherwise in good condition. Both clasps in good working order. Although the amethysts have foil backed settings, there is still some variation of colour saturation. The gold is not hallmarked, but would suggest approx. 9ct. The bracelets could be joined together if the link was repaired to make a necklace. Combined gross weight - 32.5 grams. The safety chain requires repair on both bracelets. Weight 32.7g.
