A pair of 9ct gold and ruby earclips, each designed as a stylized flowerhead, London 1953, diameter 1.8cm, with a case.

Condition Report

751. The sprung clips are in good condition, they are however not perfectly centred. The rubies are of medium to dark colour saturation. The rubies have one or two tiny chips generally at the facet edges. One ruby on one ear clip is replaced; although having a table facet the rest of the top of the stone appears to be rounded and is slightly smaller than the other rubies. The gold work is in good condition. Weight 14.4g.

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
