Condition Report

364. Generally appears to be in good condition, but there is a small crack to the inside of the neck which is largely hidden by the silver overlaid mounts. Minor chips to edge of stopper. Otherwise silver in generally good order with typically minor surface scratches and wear and a few minor dents to side of lid. Good clear hallmarks.
