Condition Report

440. Both decanters in good condition with no significant damage or repairs, no chips or cracks. Silver tops screw down nice and tight and are in good order with good clear hallmarks. Each interior would benefit from a clean. Each decanter, including silver tops are approx 18.7cm high, 7.5cm wide and 5cm deep. Outer leather case in generally good order with typical scuffs, scratches, stains and wear.
