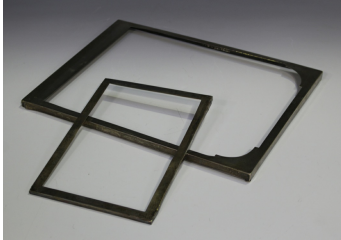

A George V silver rectangular photograph frame mount, Birmingham 1926 by Baldwin & Marriott, height 30cm, and a smaller silver rectangular photograph frame mount, Birmingham 1917 by Sanders & Mackenzie, height 20cm.

Condition Report

311. Large frame - some misshaping to sides and slightly bent to three corners. Silver otherwise ok, but with typical light surface scratches and wear. The silver is fairly sturdy, but it is typically thin as it would have been mounted on a wooden frame.

Small frame - numerous dent and misshaping, and is much thinner than the larger frame.

Both hallmarks are fairly clear. Both are just the silver frames with no rivets, the larger frame has its two swivel hinges.
