A late Victorian gold, turquoise and seed pearl necklace, circa 1890, the front mounted with a row of turquoise with seed pearl set foliate divisions, with two cluster clasps for alternative wear as a two bracelets, total length 40cm, with a case.

Estimate: £400 - £500

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### Condition Report

708. The necklace is in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Pearls and turquoise are in good order. Clasps both in working order, but one is a little loose and would need an minor adjustment to wear safely. It is missing its central pendant drop which would have been suspended at the center. The case has scuffs and wear to exterior. Interior in good order with only usual wear and marks.

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
