A diamond and black onyx bracelet, circa 1930, collet set with the principal cushion cut diamond to the centre on a black onyx ground, otherwise in a tapered Art Deco design, mounted with cushion and rose cut diamonds, on a snap clasp, length 17cm, with a case.

Condition Report

520. The bracelet is in generally good order with a few small chips to the onyx side paneling. Couple of very small repairs to the gallery sides of the mount, but only really noticeable under magnification and therefore of little significance. Clasp in good order.

The setting is not marked and difficult to tell whether it is white gold or platinum, but we think it is white gold. Central diamond is approx 0.25ct.

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
