An early 20th century American Mission Arts and Crafts oak framed armchair, probably made by Harden Co, in the manner of Gustav Stickley, the curved bar and comb back flanked by flattened armrests, the brown leather seat raised on substantial block legs, the front joints showing mortise and tenon construction, height 97cm, width 74cm, depth 62cm.
