An Italian maiolica wet drug jar, of Castel Durante type with Gubbio style lustre decoration, probably late 19th century, the bulbous body inscribed 'MIVA CITO' within a leafy garland, the angular spout flanked by foliate scrolls, with wide strap handle, height 22cm (chip to rim).

Provenance: from the collection of the late Professor Maurice Stacey.

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

No restoration.

3.5cm long chip to everted top rim to right of handle, some chipping to edge of foot, otherwise some areas/spots of glaze loss, e.g., to side of handle, tip and length of spout and main body - but generally not through the main decoration apart from one area to the top right of the 'M'.

Overall crazing to glaze.
