A Wedgwood lustre Daventry pattern Imperial bowl, 1920s, designed by Daisy Makeig-Jones, with ruby exterior and orange interior, black printed Portland vase mark to base, diameter 23.5cm.

Condition Report

The bowl 'rings' nicely when tapped.

In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

The gilding and enamels are still strong with no real wear. There are some white patches amidst the decoration - a manufacturing issue - e.g., to the base interior of the bowl and to some of the exterior panels. Some typical very light surface scratches but nothing untoward.
