A rare Coalport aesthetic japonaiserie flask, 1880s, the rich brown ground relief decorated with a gilt carp amidst silvered water swirls and green foliage, flanked by gilt enriched fin shaped handles beneath the garlic shaped neck, green printed factory mark to base with pattern No. A1897, height 17.5cm. Note: a similar vase is illustrated by Michael Messenger in 'Coalport 1795-1926', p. 317, pl. 266.

Condition Report

In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Very fine crazing to glaze only really visible on unglazed sections, e.g., neck interior and foot underside. Decoration with very, very minor spots of wear, e.g., to high point on top of fish's head.
