## Condition Report

In good condition overall with no cracks or restoration. There is a teeny, tiny smaller than pinhead sized nick to the edge of the footrim, only noticeable on very close inspection, it is just visible using the zoom function to view the second image on our website - it is in line with the top of the 'E' on the outer edge of the footrim as a tiny white mark.
