## LOT 1444

A pair of Thuringian Rudolstadt Volkstedt porcelain dishes, late 19th/early 20th century, each in the form of a crescent man in the moon, underglaze blue factory marks, length 15.5cm (restored).

## Condition Report

First moon - professional restoration to both tips of the crescent, one of which has another tiny nick to it, and similar restoration to very small chip on inner rim edge of one mouth. This moon also has a manufacturers firing crack approx 1.5m long visible to the inner and outer back end.

Second moon - more extensive professional restoration to head end and similar smaller spot to nose on one side.

The restoration is well executed overall and to the untrained eye would not be noticeable.
