## Condition Report

The glass is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There is a tiny manufacturers air bubble to the side edge of one petal at 4 o'clock.

The silk cord is very dirty and tired with at least one small repair with cotton to one of the suspension knots, it has been re-knotted to shorten its length and the tassels are frayed.
