## Condition Report

Overall fine crazing to the glaze.

The teapot has some very faint brown staining overall with a noticeable patch on the widest part of the body to the side of the green printed monogram. The spout has a line of black ink like staining to one side where it joins the main body, the knob of the cover has similar staining. 2cm long section of flange chipped away where cover sits - only visible when cover removed and doesn't stop cover from being placed in position. Gilding good with very minor wear spots.
