### LOT 1376

A Doulton Lambeth stoneware bowl, circa 1883, decorated by Frank Butler, monogrammed, with a wide band of stylized flowers and foliage above a beaded band, raised on three paw feet, impressed and incised marks to base, diameter 25.5cm, together with a pair of Art Nouveau style Doulton stoneware vases, height 17.5cm.

### Condition Report

Bowl - approx 11cm long firing crack to base underside running between two of the feet, it doesn't affect the mark at all. The base interior of the bowl is heavily scratched - it has obviously been used for keys/coins. There is also a small kiln adhesion firing blemish to the base interior.

Pair vases - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There is a pinhead sized glaze nick to the blue body towards the middle of one vase and the other vase has some rubbing to the raised tube lined detail - but these are very picky little things.
