An extensive Herend Rothschild Bird pattern dinner service, comprising a large circular two handled tureen and cover, sauce boat with stand, five crescent shaped dishes, seven fan shaped dishes, eleven plates, diameter 26.5cm, twelve plates, diameter 21cm, twelve plates, diameter 18cm, eleven two handled soup bowls and twelve saucers, twelve two handled dessert bowls with rose knopped covers and saucers, eleven miniature tureens with lemon knopped covers and two spare rose knopped circular covers, blue printed and painted marks to bases, together with a Meissen pin dish.

## Condition Report

The vendor of the service explained the family used it a handful of times, this would explain the immaculate condition. The enamels and gilding are good and bright throughout. There are some minor knife cuts to the dinner plates in particular, but nothing untoward or unsightly.

One dinner plate has a flat chip to the underside rim edge - not visible from the upper surface.

One dessert bowl saucer has a hairline.

Otherwise there are no condition issues.
