An Italian pottery model of a seated Scottish Terrier, mid-20th century, by Guido Cacciapuoti and Silvio Righetto, painted in red, yellow and black, incised signatures to side of base and numbered '601', height 26.5cm.

Condition Report

Red left eyebrow has a glued repair to the tip and nicks to two of the other pointed ends, the right eyebrow has small chips to two of its pointed ends, the right ear tip has a narrow chip along its edge, the left ear has a rubbed top. The tip of the tail is fritted. Otherwise there are some small nicks/chips to the high point edges of the coat detail overall - nothing too terrible and not really noticeable because of the decoration - apart from one black section on the left hind quarter, just visible using the zoom function on the images on our website. The enamels overall are good with no flaking or wear.
