A Limoges part dessert service, early 20th century, decorated with a central gilt medallion within a gilt overlaid cobalt blue rim, comprising twelve plates, two comports and four stands, green printed marks to bases with W. Pearce, Bayswater, London, retailer's stamp.

## Condition Report

The service is overall in good condition with no restoration or cracks. There is obviously wear to the gilding and this primarily seems to be in the form of stacking wear to the high points and then typical rubbing to the rims. This wear is in varying degrees, a few of the pieces have very noticeable wear to the central medallions - most noticeable on one of the plates, one of the tazza's and two of the stands. One of the tazza's has a tiny chip to the upper rim edge of the foot, and two of the plates have tiny chips to the upper rim edges - hardly noticeable apart from on close inspection.
