A pair of John Derbyshire uranium green pressed glass paperweights, circa 1874, in the form of recumbent lions, raised on fluted oval bases, diamond registration lozenge and anchor mark to both, length 17.5cm.

### Condition Report

Both lions have some chipping to the fluted edges of the bases, slightly more so on one of the lions where it is more on the actual footrim - we have tried to show this in the images on our website but it is tricky to capture. The chipping is not overly detrimental and due to the nature of the fluting is really only noticeable on closer inspection. Otherwise the lions are in good condition with no cracks, chips or repairs.
