A pair of Royal Worcester porcelain figures of Bacchus and Ariadne, late 19th century, each modelled reclining on a naturalistic base, model Nos. 2/72 and 2/73, unmarked, lengths 31cm and 33cm (some restoration).

### Condition Report

1564. Bacchus - restoration to left foot, with overpainting to the whole leg and toe of right foot, now discoloured. Hairline crack running on the underside, from front edge across two thirds of underside of base. Faint firing crack to back of robes, with evidence of past overpainting which is now flaking away. Chip to pink hair ribbon, previously restored. Minor rubbing to gilding.

Ariadne - restoration to left foot, now discoloured. Couple of nibbles to glaze of orange edging on robe. Otherwise ok.
