A pair of Doulton Lambeth stoneware bottle vases, late 19th century, blue glazed with floral and textured panel decoration, impressed and incised marks to bases, height 29.3cm, together with two Minton Haddon Hall vases and covers (one knob glued), and a small Doulton Burslem pot.

Condition Report

Pair Doulton Vases - one has a very well executed professionally restored small chip to the outer edge of the foot, only noticeable by an expert eye - otherwise both in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. The gilding is rubbed and there are some minor and light surface scratches.

Burslem pot - in good condition overall.

Two Minton vases and covers - the knob on the cover of the taller example has been glued, otherwise both are ok.
