An English porcelain two handled rectangular dish, of Daniel type, circa 1830, painted with a titled view of Sterling Castle within a gilt overlaid green ground border edged with a shaped cream rim flanked by pierced gilt handles, length 36cm, together with a cabinet plate painted with a titled view of Dunstanburgh Castle, Northumberland, diameter 27cm.

Condition Report

1585. Two-handled rectangular dish:

Faint hairline to rim at approx 4 o'clock, mainly noticeable from the reverse. Some minor light crazing to both handles, again only noticeable on the reverse. Some scratching to central painted scene, including beside the rider and above the castle. Some light wear to the green and gilt border/rim. Small dent to the right handle edge.

Cabinet plate:

A couple of small scratching in the sky on the central painted scene. Otherwise plate is in generally good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.
