A Lalique sepia stained glass Art Deco Deux Chèvres hand mirror, designed 1927, of circular shape with central handle, moulded with opposing goats amidst fruiting vine, the plated mount edge marked 'LALIQUE', diameter 16.3cm.

## Condition Report

The glass is in good condition overall with a couple of teeny tiny nicks to the rim edge which are really inconsequential and only noticeable on very close inspection, they are hardly worth mentioning.

The plated rim has a very subtle misshapen spot which is more easily felt than seen, again hardly worth mentioning, the plating is completely worn.

The mirror has degraded around the outside edge.
