LOT 1704

A small mixed group of glassware, 19th and 20th century, including a pair of Webb clear cut glass decanters and stoppers, height 30.5cm, a pair of Bristol blue glass club shaped decanters and stoppers with gilt 'Rum' labels, height 24cm, and four apothecary jars (faults and repairs).

Estimate: £40 - £60

Condition Report

Pair Webb decanters - one with major chip to top rim edge, other with minor nicks to facet edges, one stopper with nick to tip, other stopper with small chips to base end.

Two blue Rum decanters - one with badly broken and visibly glued neck, other with teeny tiny nick to upper rim edge and some minor clouding. One stopper with chip to side edge, other badly broken and visibly glued.

Two blue apothecary jars - one badly cracked and chipped, other with later replacement label, extensive surface scratches and wear, one stopper with major chip.

Two blue goblets - smaller with 2 chips to foot, other ok.

Two clear apothecary jars - taller with minor polished fault to top of stopper, otherwise both ok.

Two blue beakers - one with tiny nick to base edge, other with a few nicks to white rim, both with completely worn gilding.

Cranberry tinted beaker - good condition.
