A Meissen part service, late 19th century, outside factory decorated, painted with panels of courting couples in 18th century dress within gilt frames against a gilt overlaid claret red ground, comprising nine plates, nine teacups and saucers, cancelled crossed swords in underglaze blue to bases (minor faults).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

Plates - one has a 2cm long by 0.5cm wide chip to the upper rim edge at 4 o'clock, otherwise all in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. The central painted panels are all in good order, but the gilding on each plate is worn/rubbed to varying degrees, some very badly in areas (completely missing) whilst lightly affected in other areas, there is also some minor stacking wear to the cavetto's.

Cups and Saucers - all in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, the painted panels are all in good order but again the gilding is heavily worn to varying degrees apart from on the rims.
