A Prattware Bear, Lion and Cock pot lid, 19th century, diameter 7.5cm, together with five other pot lids, including The New Blackfriars Bridge, three framed, two reference books on pot lids, two Staffordshire figures of Red Riding Hood and three other pieces.

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

Bear, Lion and Cock - crazing to glaze with small restored chip to base edge.

New Blackfriars Bridge - finely crazed with light staining visible primarily to underside and minor nick to base edge.

Ice Skating - nibbled chips and staining to base edge.

Strasbourg - heavily crazed with chipping to base edge circumference and staining to underside.

Pegwell Bay - some scratches, otherwise ok.

Village Wedding - crazed with light staining to underside, some chipping to base edge and minor rubbing to rim edge.

The frames need attention.

Lady Toby - hat visibly poorly restored, crazed.

Red Riding Hood - in good condition overall, minor firing faults to enamel of cloak.

Equestrian figure - crazed, firing crack and chipping to footrim, cloak flaking.

Books - both in overall good condition, some damp spots.
