Condition Report

Sight - dog missing right hind leg, bottom and tail. Pretty much all of ribbon detail from hair/hat and dress missing from back of figure. One large chip and 2 smaller to brim of hat, typical minor losses to lacework detail of dress.

Smell - small chip to back right corner base edge, chips and losses to applied leaves in plant pot on table, on hat, in hand held to nose and in apron on lap. Small hole to front of neck where circular lacework detail is missing, typical minor losses to lacework detail of dress.
