A Meissen pierced oval basket, 19th century, painted to the base interior with a floral bouquet, the exterior trellis work with a blue flowerhead at each intersection, flanked by branch handles with floral encrusted terminals, crossed swords in underglaze blue to base, incised No. 57, impressed 73, length 29.8cm (restoration to handles).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

The main body of the basket is in good condition overall with a couple of minor chips to the edges of the lattice visible to the interior side.

One handle is very badly completely restored with flaking/peeling re-painting and losses and traces of restoration to the applied flowers and foliage, part of this restored handle is possibly made-up.

The other handle is ok but has significant losses and traces of old restoration to the applied flowers and foliage.
