A Baccarat glass pansy paperweight, circa 1850, the yellow and purple flower on a short stem, surrounded by a flowerbud and leaves above a star cut base, diameter approx 6.5cm.

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

There is an approx 0.5cm square flat chip to the side edge of the footrim, together with a similar smaller alongside and a number of tiny nicks to the footrim circumference. There are two small bruises to the end of the star cut to the underside, and a couple of small bruises to the dome too. Otherwise the dome is a good size with typical minor surface scratches/wear. There are typical manufacturer's flaws to the interior of the paperweight.
