Provenance: from the collection of the late Professor Maurice Stacey.

Condition Report

Fundamentally the vase is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

There is overall manufacturing pitting to the glaze and a few minor manufacturer's blemishes. Otherwise there are some typical minor frits to the glaze around the top rim and less so to the footrim.
