A large Continental porcelain Meissen style potpourri vase and pierced cover, late 19th century, the high shouldered body painted with birds on branches flanked by gilt enriched scroll handles, the cover with acanthus knob, underglaze blue mark to rim, height 36cm (crack to cover).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

There is a tiny flat chip less than 0.5cm square to the outer rim edge of the main body above one of the bird panels, and a similar but even smaller nick to the side edge of one of the handles. Otherwise the main body is in good condition with some light surface scratches to the widest part of the body. The gilding overall is a bit rubbed/worn.

The cover has a 1.5cm long narrow chip to the inner rim edge, chipping to the tip of the knob and a haircrack running across the diameter - to the side of the knob - from the piercing on one side to the other.
