### LOT 534

A group of silver mounted jewellery, comprising a Scottish circular brooch in a Celtic design, Edinburgh 1965, diameter 4.7cm, a brooch decorated with a floral spray, circa 1900, three further brooches, two heart shaped pendant lockets, two rings and a postage stamps case, designed as an envelope, total weight 66.5g.

Estimate: £50 - £70

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### Condition Report

534. Circular Celtic design brooch – engraved to the back ‘To Mum from Peter Christmas 1966’, otherwise good condition.

Floral spray brooch – old solder repair to hinge pin, otherwise some of the surrounded beads are a bit dented, otherwise ok condition.

Butterfly wing brooch – is rather faded.

Red paste trefoil brooch – very dirty but otherwise ok. One heart shaped pendant locket is missing its suspension loop and has a few dents at the back.

Butterfly wing ring – a bit faded and scratched.

Smoky quartz ring – uneven colour saturation.

Envelope stamp case – is a little tired, dented and worn, hallmark a bit faint.

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
