A rose cut diamond and lapis lazuli stickpin, designed as an arrow piercing a bead, width 2.2cm, a gold topped and diamond single stone stickpin, detailed '15c', and six further stickpins.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

537. Lapis lazuli stickpin – arrow is a bit bent and would benefit from careful straightening, the pin is attached to the top with lead solder, one or two chips by the drill holes of the lapis lazuli bead.

Diamond topped openwork stickpin – solder visible at the highest point, diamond looks to be a clear stone.

Scarab stickpin – is in good condition. One of the horseshoe stickpins is missing part of its riding crop.

The remaining stickpins have one or two signs of wear typical with age but are in reasonable condition,
