A late Victorian 18ct gold, opal and diamond ring, mounted with three oval opals alternating with two pairs of cushion cut diamonds, Birmingham 1900, weight 3.4g, ring size approx L1/2.

Condition Report

539. One of the smaller opals has a chip, all opals have some degree of surface wear, one of the diamonds has surface reaching inclusions/chip to the table facet, hallmarks clear, back of shank has damage/split near the makers mark, to solder repair this you would loss definition of the markers mark. The ring would benefit from professional cleaning.

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
