### LOT 558

A pair of silver octagonal cufflinks, probably 18th century, decorated with roses to the centre, indistinct maker's mark but possibly TH, a button, a stud and a gold mounted watch key, probably late 18th century, length 3.3cm.

Estimate: £40 - £60

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### Condition Report

558. Cufflinks ♦ are a bit tarnished but are in generally good condition for their age, slight wear to the connecting bar terminals.

Button ♦ good condition for age.

Stud ♦ is base metal.

Watch key ♦ is missing its top loop, some evidence of rusting to the key end.

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
