A moonstone set plaid brooch in a Celtic design, width 5.5cm, a gold, seed pearl and pale blue gem set circular brooch, diameter 2.3cm, a foil backed colourless paste collar necklace, length 38cm, a pair of colourless paste pendant earrings and a small group of other costume jewellery.

Condition Report

564. Moonstone plaid brooch � good condition, rather tarnished, unmarked.

Pale blue gem set brooch � repair to mount near brooch pin is impressed with the digit 4, in our view this mark has no relation to the main piece.

Collar necklace � one paste missing, the back of the front cluster has a hook fitting to hold a drop, which is now absent, unmarked, the piece is probably 19th century silver.

Pendant earring to detailed \$935\$, top screw fittings are detailed \$silver\$.

Buckle � some bubbling with apparent loss of enamel, size assembled 7.5cm.

Yellow and colourless paste pendant � the lower rectangular yellow paste is chipped, some discoloration to the colourless pastes, would benefit from professional cleaning, all small colourless pastes present.

Gilt flower brooch � missing pin.

Filigree bracelet � clasp needs repair.

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
