## LOT 588

A gold and garnet single stone pendant in a foliate scrolling drop shaped design, mounted with a cushion cut garnet, weight 2.5g, length 3.5cm, with a gilt metal neckchain, and a gold and cabochon green gem set pendant, designed as a stylized acorn, weight 3.5g, length 2.7cm.

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## Condition Report

588. Garnet pendant: in good condition, hollow construction, with two tiny apparent holes, the pendant is probably made from the principal drop of a Victorian earring, unmarked, likely to be over gilded so difficult to test for gold or be accurate in its grade.

Acorn pendant: solder visible below the suspension loop of the pendant, otherwise fair condition, probably foreign gold, untested, but the mark is unreadable, the pendant probably came from a charm bracelet.

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
