An Andrew Grima platinum, sapphire and diamond cluster ring, circa 1975, in a pierced geometric abstract design, claw set with the oval cut sapphire within a surround of circular cut diamonds, detailed 'Plat', weight 9.2g, ring size approx J1/2, sapphire weight approx 1.5ct.

Condition Report

612. The sapphire is of medium to pale colour saturation, there are a couple of tiny nicks to the edge of the sapphire, the diamonds slightly draw colour, the diamonds are eight cut stones and they look to be fairly clear, a few surface marks to the back of the shank of the ring, the vertical line on the shank of the ring is a solder joint. The shank is marked Grima though is worn with some loss of lettering, the ring is marked Plat, this is well defined and readable, there is no full hallmark. There is no box or papers. The piece has been insured by the vendor as a Andrew Grima piece in the past and they believe that their father purchased the piece new as a Andrew Grima piece.

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
