Condition Report

623. Slight dehydration cracking to the opal visible more so from the back, the opal is otherwise in good condition with no significant chips or scratches, the opal has play of colour principally of green and violet tones, there is no orange or red play of colour to the stone, the back to the opal is natural opal, the opal is domed to back and front, probable maximum depth 5mm, the diamonds are attractive white stones, the brooch is generally in good condition. All diamonds are present. Clasp is in good original condition and in working order.

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
