A gold and silver set diamond ring, possibly last quarter of the 18th century, in a spray design, mounted with a principal pear shaped rose cut diamond, otherwise set with smaller rose cut diamonds, weight 3.3g, ring size approx G1/2 (two diamonds lacking), in a gilt metal rectangular box.

Condition Report

634. The principal missing diamond is at the top end of the spray, a further small rose diamond is missing from one of the two stone leaf sprays, the shank is rather thin at the back and evidence of resizing in the past, evidence of two supporting panels at the back of the front of the ring that seems to be an old repair, the principal diamond draws colour, with a few internal inclusions and the silver around the edge is rather worn down.

Gilt metal box ♦ hinged lidded box that might date from 1920s/30s, the box is in association with the ring.

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
