A silver and citrine brooch, designed as a twin thistle spray, Edinburgh 1962, weight 11.9g, diameter 4.5cm, a gold and imitation bar brooch, detailed '9ct', weight 2g, width 4.5cm, a Venetian glass and gilt metal blue bead necklace and a green glass bead necklace.

Condition Report

712. Twin-thistle brooch ♦ pin rather bent at the back.

Imitation turquoise brooch ♦ note imitation turquoise, back of brooch is fitted with a hook to hold possibly a fob watch, detailed ♦9ct♦.

Blue bead necklace ♦ the plain blue beads are of a matted appearance in imitation of lapis lazuli, the Venetian glass beads are in good condition.

Green necklace ♦ some loss of applied decoration to the three pendant drops at the front, the metal work is a bit corroded caused by damp.

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
