### LOT 1944

A collection of USA coins, comprising a half-dollar 1836, two further half-dollars, 1875 and 1908 (previously mounted as a brooch), a twenty-five cents 1818, a one dollar 1980 and a quarter-dollar 1999.

Estimate: £60 - £90

### Condition Report

1944. 1836 half dollar ♦ general overall circulation wear, there are a few indentations above the date and an old scratch running through 836 of the date, the reverse ♦ overall signs of circulation wear, definition of the lettering of united is rather weak and there are three surface marks by T of united, six comma shaped surface indentation at the top of the back of the coin, edge lettering weak in places.

1875 half dollar ♦ group of stain blotches to the front of the figure, loss of definition to the letter of liberty on the shield, overall significant circulation wear, the reverse ♦ wear to definition of In God We Trust scroll above the eagle, general circulation wear to the coin, one or two rim edge knocks.

1908 half dollar ♦ coin front has fairly light circulation wear, the reverse ♦ damage as the result of solder brooch fittings, surface scratch across the shield and to the right of the half, mint mark O.

25 cents 1818 ♦ overall a rather worn coin, with uniform wear and some indented marks in places, we would suggest a grading of fair.

1999 quarter dollar ♦ is Connecticut and has circulation marks.
