A George III sovereign 1820.

Estimate: £300 - £400

Condition Report

1820 Sovereign observe – indentation towards the bottom of the neck, surface wear to the kings portrait, wreath and hair, a few rim line edge knocks.

Sovereign Reverse – there is a striation across the surface running from I of HONI to I of QUI, there is another striation lower down running from the beginning of the belt near the buckle through the dragon and up to the fullstop between MAL and Y. We do not know what has caused these flaws but suggest that it is a result of the coining process rather than a form of subsequent damage. This taken into account our opinion of grade would be good fine.
