Condition Report

311. The movement winds smoothly and runs and keeps good time over an hour testing period, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock.

The clock is in generally good condition. The case is in good order with only very minor surface scratches and wear. Dial has some minor wear and discolouration. Glass in good order.

The brass easel stand is designed to be curved, so when it is packed up the stand folds around the movement and does not stick out too much, however it is still a little misshapen and wobbly at the hinge, but is fairly solid when fully extended and in place.
