A Victorian 15ct gold, ruby and diamond set three stone ring in a buckle and strap design, Birmingham 1884, weight 2.2g, ring size approx O, another Victorian gold ring, glazed with a rectangular hair locket, weight 3.2g, ring size approx N, and a 9ct gold band ring in a chainlink design, weight 3.8g, ring size approx H.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

Buckle - diamond has chip to top of stone to the side of the table facet, rubies are of medium colour saturation and look to be in good condition. Ring generally in good condition, although hallmark clear the maker's mark is weak. Some code marks scratched within the band.

Locket - minor surface wear to glazing, slightly gappy corners, no inscription or hallmarks.

Chainlink - some wear to sides where been in contact with other rings.

All 3 would benefit from professional cleaning.
