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A diamond brooch in a tied ribbon bow design, mounted with circular cut and rose cut diamonds, width 5cm (two diamonds lacking).

Estimate: £400 - £500

Condition Report

The brooch is reconstructed. The back of the frame of the mount is added, split at the back of the mount. Where the two diamonds are missing it is cracked through and broken at this point.

The piece has been reconstructed to an extent that it is difficult to perceive how it was originally made. It is possible the front of the brooch originally formed part of a bracelet.

There is some variation to the cut of the diamonds overall, generally attractive white stones with one or two internal inclusions.

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
