A George IV gold and black enamelled mourning ring, glazed with an oval locket compartment within a black enamelled surround, the shank with black enamelled decoration, with inscription and date '1822', weight 2.2g, ring size approx S1/2.

Condition Report

Central glazed locket shows the mirror backing but no hairwork within. Enamel chipped and cracked at back of shank, the enamel work has probably been restored/replaced in the past. Inscription although original to the ring has been cleaned in the past.

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
