Condition Report

375. All hallmarks are slightly rubbed but perfectly readable and all hallmarks on nozzles are matching. All four candlesticks have an engraved monogram on the base and on each nozzle.

Candlesticks appear to be in generally good order with typical light surface wear and scratches, some minor small dents and knocks but nothing significant. No repairs. However, there is typical wear to high points and on the shoulder knop of the stem. Some of these high points have worn right through. On three of the lower knops on the stem the arch panels have split away ever so slightly.
